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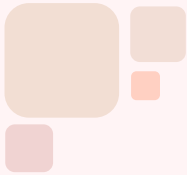
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Message from **ARVIND KUMAR** Director General, STPI



Marking more than three decades of unwavering service to India's technology sector, the Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) commemorated its 34th Foundation Day on 5th June 2025 with immense pride and grandeur. The occasion was not merely a celebration, it was a powerful reflection of STPI's transformative journey that began in 1991 and has since redefined India's global standing in the IT and software exports industry.

Since its inception, STPI has played a pioneering role in shaping India's digital economy. What began with just three centres at a time when the Indian IT sector was still in its infancy has now evolved into a robust network of 67 centres strategically located across the country. These centres have been instrumental in decentralizing the IT revolution, taking technology and innovation from metro cities to Tier-II and Tier-III locations, thereby fostering inclusive and regionally balanced growth.

The Foundation Day celebration highlighted India's remarkable digital journey and STPI's pivotal role in it. From facilitating early-stage IT exports to becoming a catalyst for deep-tech innovation, STPI has continuously adapted to meet the evolving needs of the Indian technology ecosystem.

While promoting software and IT-enabled services (ITeS) exports remains a core focus, STPI's role has significantly transformed in recent years. In alignment with the Government of India's vision for a Digital India and an Atmanirbhar Bharat, STPI has expanded its mandate to promote startups, innovation, and deep technologies. One of the key focus areas has been the dispersal of the IT industry to emerging cities, ensuring that talent and innovation are tapped across the entire country and not just in metropolitan centres.

Through its 24 Centres of Entrepreneurship (CoEs) and the Next Generation Incubation Scheme (NGIS), STPI is nurturing India's startup ecosystem with sector-specific support across domains like Artificial Intelligence, Blockchain, IoT, MedTech and FinTech. These CoEs offer infrastructure, mentorship, funding access, and networking opportunities to early-stage startups, helping them scale and succeed.

So far, the STPI ecosystem has supported over 1,400 Startups, which have collectively raised more than ₹574 crore from various investors. These numbers not only reflect the impact and credibility of the STPI startup ecosystem but also underscore its effectiveness in bridging the gap between ideation and commercialization in India's fast-evolving digital economy.

Originally established to provide data communication, incubation, and facilitation services for IT/ITeS exports, STPI has now become a cornerstone of India's digital economy. It acts as a bridge between government policy and grassroots innovation, enabling entrepreneurs, startups, and small businesses to contribute meaningfully to India's tech-led development.

On this momentous day, as all STPI centres across India joined in the celebrations, the organization reaffirmed its commitment to fostering a more inclusive, innovative, and self-reliant India. With a focus on indigenous technologies, digital empowerment, and industry-academia collaboration, STPI aims to continue being a driving force in India's journey toward becoming a global innovation hub.

Looking ahead, STPI is poised to scale new heights by expanding its national footprint, launching more domain-specific CoEs, and deepening its support for emerging technologies. These CoEs will serve as collaborative hubs for research, innovation, and entrepreneurship, empowering startups and MSMEs to develop world-class products and solutions. By fostering an enabling ecosystem, STPI is reinforcing India's emergence as a global hub for next-generation technologies.

Kathaipetti (a unit of Vinrag Media Private Ltd) Personalised Storytelling for the Next Generation



M/s Kathaipetti, incubated at STPI Efficiency Augmentation CoE in Bengaluru, is revolutionising early childhood experiences through AI-powered storytelling in Indian languages. The Kathaipetti app has garnered over 5,000 users with 28% Day-7 retention and 20% users spending over 10 minutes daily.

Kathaipetti is founded by a trio, including Nithya, Hari Krishnan and Sanakara Subramanian, with diverse roots in HR, branding, AI & tech, storytelling and media, all united by a shared mission to build screen-free, culturally-rich experiences for children.

The platform leverages GenAI voice cloning to reproduce voices of parents, grandparents and other loved ones, enabling children to experience stories in an emotionally-resonant, familiar voice. Kathaipetti also offers character personalisation and is preparing to launch a companion audio device, built in response to parental feedback about overstimulating content prevalent today that is affecting childhood development. Their upcoming device will focus on delivering immersive stories through minimal-screen experience.

With an emphasis on cultural preservation, regional language promotion and human connection through technology, Kathaipetti is not just telling stories, it's building a storytelling future for the world!



Kathaipetti started casually over a birthday party chat between the three of us. We were just talking about how tough it is to find meaningful, culturally-rooted and safe content for our kids and what really makes a great gift for children today. That simple conversation led to a full-fledged product that now has 5,000+ users and is quickly moving toward commercialisation. None of this would've been possible without our small but diverse and passionate team, who've put their heart into building this. Our dream is to blend AI voice and personalisation to create magical experiences for children while preserving our languages and culture. We're at the intersection of tech, edutainment and identity and we're just getting started.

STPI clocks 34 years of enabling innovation, IT and tech excellence

Marking more than three decades of service to India’s technology sector, STPI celebrated its 34th Foundation Day on 5th June, 2025 in all glory and pride. The event reflected STPI’s transformative journey since its establishment, including its role in positioning India as a global leader in software exports.

From merely three centres in 1991 to a robust network of 67 centres today, STPI’s journey reflects a remarkable legacy of scaling innovation and propelling the IT/ITeS industry to Tier-II/III cities of India. From strengthening India’s IT exports to advancing deep-tech and frontier technologies, in the past 34 years, STPI has remained steadfast at the forefront in making the nation a tech superpower.

On the occasion, Director General, STPI, Shri Arvind Kumar, stated, “Today is a proud moment for STPI. STPI started its journey with three centres, and at that time, the IT industry was at a nascent stage. Now, STPI has 67 centres across the country and these centres have played a vital role in transforming the IT industry. In 2024-25, the exports done by STPI-registered units have reached more than ₹10 lakh crores. Aligned with the mandate of the Government of India, STPI is working for the dispersal of the IT industry to Tier-II & Tier-III cities of the country for inclusive growth. Also, STPI is nurturing the tech startup ecosystem across India through its 24 Centres of Entrepreneurship (CoEs) and NGIS and supported more than 1,400 startups. Startups empowered through the STPI ecosystem have raised funds of Rs. 574 crores from investors so far. Initiated with facilitating IT/ITeS exports, incubation and data communication services, STPI has grown into a key pillar of the nation’s digital and innovation ecosystem. We remain deeply committed to empowering the Indian startup ecosystem across the country, making innovation truly inclusive.”
